Frequently Asked Questions

Which online platform will these Virtual Field Trips be offered on?

- Our Virtual Field Trip sessions will streamed live using ZOOM. We may be utilizing videos during the sessions to enhance the virtual field trip experience.
- Before your scheduled Virtual Field Trip session, an email will be sent to you with the Zoom link for your specific session, along with Zoom instructions

How long is a Virtual Field Trip session?

• Each Virtual Field Trip session is 1 hour long. Each session has a similar structure with a different theme depending on the grade-level of the students.

How many students may join the video call?

• There will be a maximum of 50 students that will be allowed in each session

Are there any scholarships available?

• There grant funding available for Title 1 students/groups.

• Simply select the option "Yes", when prompted with, "Is this School Title 1, and are you interested in a class stipend?", on our intake form. We will follow up with you regarding availability.

What is my role as the Teacher?

• As a Teacher, we only ask that you help us moderate your students on camera and through chat. We ask that we maintain a school-appropriate chatroom and reserve the right to disable the chat if this cannot happen.

What type of technology will families need to access the Virtual Field Trip platform? Will a smartphone, tablet, PC, Mac, Chromebook work?

• In order to participate, students will need access to the internet. Although smartphones can access the Zoom application, using a tablet, laptop or desktop computer of any brand will allow for more versatile and interactive participation.
